Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification Schemes

We are Australia's largest wholesaler of Engineered Wood Products, including our SmartFrame range of Timber I-Joist (SmartJoist), Laminated Veneer Lumber (SmartLVL), and Glued Laminated Beams (SmartLam). Our Architectural Products division uses traditional timber milling and profiling methods to create aesthetically pleasing timber products for both interior and exterior spaces, in both Western Red Cedar and Tasmanian Oak.

At Tilling, we are dedicated to environmentally responsible practices and the use of sustainable resources. We have implemented Chain of Custody (CoC) procedures to ensure compliance with the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC) standards. Our objective is to maintain a transparent communication link between our suppliers and Tilling Timber Pty Ltd, ensuring evidence of environmentally sound business practices and proof that the wood supplied comes from sustainably managed sources.

Tilling Timber Pty Ltd is committed to implementing this policy, maintaining our Chain of Custody certification in collaboration with our certification body, PEFC, and ensuring this statement is adhered to.

Since 2012, Australia has enforced illegal logging prohibition laws to combat illegal logging and to promote the trade of legal timber products. These laws are outlined in the Illegal Logging Prohibition Act 2012 and the Illegal Logging Prohibition Regulation 2012. As an importer of wood and wood products into Australia, Tilling Timber Pty Ltd complies with these laws in addition to meeting all requirements of the PEFC standard.
